ITINERARY

Day 1, Sunday October 29, 2017

Arrive in Berlin, Germany

Welcome to Berlin! At 6 pm, meet your Tour Director and traveling companions, then enjoy this evening's welcome dinner with wine at your hotel. (Dinner)

Day 2, Monday October 30, 2017

Berlin-Jüterbog-Dessau

Sightseeing includes the restored Reichstag, Charlottenburg Castle, a picture stop at monumental Brandenburg Gate, the Holocaust Memorial, and the Victory Column. Visit the KAISER WILHELM MEMORIAL CHURCH with its bomb-damaged tower and pass Checkpoint Charlie. In the afternoon, stop in Jüterbog to see St. Nicholas Church and hear about the Pulpit dispute. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 3, Tuesday October 31, 2017 (Reformation Day)

Dessau. Excursion To Wittenberg

In Dessau, visit PRINCE GEORGE III LIBRARY with its collection of works by Luther. Your guided walking tour in Wittenberg takes in Luther House, where Martin Luther and his family lived, followed by a visit to the twin-towered, gothic ST. MARY'S CHURCH, where Luther preached the Reformation, got married (1525), and baptized his six children. Finally, see the door of the Castle Church where Luther posted his 95 Theses against the sale of indulgences in 1517. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 4, Wednesday November 1, 2017

Dessau-Torgau-Leipzig

Visit Torgau, the political center of the Reformation, where Luther sanctified the first Protestant church. Arrive in Leipzig for your walking tour and visit the THOMASKIRCHE, where J.S. Bach worked. Visit the market square that today is a site for celebrations and festivals. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 5, Thursday November 2, 2017

Leipzig-Mansfield-Eisleben-Erfurt

Today, stop in Mansfeld, city of Martin Luther's childhood and see his parents' home. Next, in Eisleben visit LUTHER'S BIRTHPLACE MUSEUM, LUTHER'S DEATH HOUSE MUSEUM, and ST. PETER & PAUL CHURCH. Later, drive to Erfurt, where Martin Luther spent his student days. Highlight of the day is a visit to the AUGUSTINIAN MONASTERY, where Luther lived as a monk. (Breakfast)

Day 6, Friday November 3, 2017

Erfurt. Excursion to Eisenach and Schmalkalden

Journey to Eisenach and enjoy a guided visit to WARTBURG CASTLE, where Luther translated the New Testament. Also visit LUTHER HOUSE, ST. GEORGE'S CHURCH, and see the Luther and Bach Memorials. Continue to medieval Schmalkalden and see St. George's Church. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 7, Saturday November 4, 2017

Erfurt-Coburg-Mainz

In Coburg, where Luther stayed in 1530 for the Imperial Diet of Augsburg, visit fascinating COBURG FORTRESS, one of the largest surviving medieval fortresses in Germany. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 8, Sunday November 5, 2017

Mainz. Excursion to Worms & The Rhine Valley

In Worms, where the Imperial Council passed judgment on Luther in 1521, visit the CATHEDRAL where Luther presented his case, as well as TRINITY CHURCH and the famed REFORMATION MONUMENT. Later, enjoy a scenic RHINE CRUISE past castle- crested cliffs, terraced vineyards, and trim, half-timbered towns. Evening at leisure. (Breakfast)

Day 9, Monday November 6, 2017

Mainz-Rothenburg-Nuremberg

This morning, visit the GUTENBERG MUSEUM in Mainz, where original copies of the Bible can be seen. Next is the medieval walled town of Rothenburg. During your walking tour, visit ST. JACOB'S CHURCH with the renowned Blood Altar. Afterwards, there is time to shop for Christmas ornaments, for which this picturesque town is world famous. Continue to Nuremberg, the first town to accept the Reformation in 1525. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 10, Tuesday November 7, 2017

Nuremberg-Augsburg-Munich

Your walking tour in Nuremberg features the famous ST. LORENZ LUTHERAN CHURCH. Continue to Augsburg, where your guided sightseeing reveals the city where Luther and his followers proclaimed their beliefs. Arrive in Munich. (Breakfast)

Day 11, Wednesday November 8, 2017

Munich

Sightseeing with a Local Guide of Germany's "Secret Capital" includes the Olympic Stadium, MARIENPLATZ with the Old and the New Town Halls, and the gothic Frauenkirche. Tonight, enjoy a farewell dinner with wine at your hotel. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 12, Thursday November 9, 2017

Munich

Your vacation ends with breakfast this morning. (Breakfast)
