

Conference Information

The conference begins on Monday, November 14, at 6:00pm, and concludes on Wednesday, November 16, at noon. Lodging is provided for Monday and Tuesday as part of the conference fee. This requires two people per room. Roommate preferences may be submitted with registration. A limited number of single rooms are available for an added cost. The hotel is located two blocks from Grace Lutheran Church where the conference will be held.

Meals & Transportation

Conference attendees are responsible for their own travel and costs, including transportation from the airport to the hotel. Tucson International Airport is less than 10 miles from the conference location and Sky Harbor International Airport in Phoenix is 100 miles away.

The following meals and snacks are provided as part of the conference fee. On Monday evening, light appetizers and non-alcoholic beverages will be served as part of the social hour. On Tuesday evening, all attendees will be treated to a relaxing dinner at Gentle Ben's Brewing Co. It is a block from the hotel, and there will be a cash bar available to purchase alcoholic beverages at your own cost. A catered hot breakfast and a catered lunch will be served at church on Monday and Tuesday. Wednesday lunch is provided and is able to be carried out. Water, coffee, and snacks will be available at the church throughout the conference.
